How can you join?

The Senior's Day Habilitation program is a service that provides older individuals with a meaningful day program offering group and individual social, health-related, and recreational activities that develop and maintain appropriate social behaviors, communication skills, and safety and healthcare skills that are related to an individual's service plan. Many individuals choose to attend our program after they retire and no longer work. The program is designed to enable an individual to improve and maintain his or her self-help, social, and adaptive skills.

Chemung ARC offers a full day program (8:30am - 3:00pm), filled with fun activities planned on a monthly basis including daily outings that promote community inclusion.



Eligibility

An individual who is eligible for the Seniors Day Hab program must meet the eligibility requirements for OMRDD services.

The Seniors Program is a Medicaid funded program. Candidates must be eligible for Medicaid, be HCBS Waiver enrolled or be eligible for mirrored services.
